Dr. William E Silver was honored by his peers to receive the Lester Brown Lifetime Service Award at the annual meeting of the Georgia Society of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery, July 27, 2006, at the Cloister. This award is given to a surgeon who has been in practice for more than twenty years, has contributed by teaching medicine, and has been involved in local and national service projects that have benefited his specialty.

Dr. Silver is a native of Atlanta and has practiced in the field of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery for over thirty years. He is the founder and President of Premier Image Cosmetic and Laser Surgery and founded Dunwoody Outpatient Surgery Center, a nationally accredited outpatient surgery center located in Dunwoody, Georgia. This combination of services Georgia's first multi-specialty cosmetic surgery practice to offer a complete range of services to the patient.

On the faculty of Emory University, Dr. Silver has been involved in teaching since he went into practice. He has served as a fellowship director for the American Academy Facial Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery for the past fifteen years. He is the author of many papers published in his specialty's publications and has co-written text books as well.

Dr. Silver has served as the Vice President of both the American Academy Otolaryngology/Head and Neck Surgery and the American Academy Facial Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery, the largest regional plastic surgery society. In addition to these duties, he has served as Chairman of the Board Otolaryngology of Georgia for the American Academy Otolaryngology/Head & Neck Surgery and as President of both the Georgia Society of Otolaryngology/Head & Neck Surgery and the Metro Atlanta Otolaryngology Study Organization. He also served as the chairman of the medical division for the Atlanta Jewish Federation.

Dr. Silver, his wife, and two children reside here in Atlanta. They are passionately active in local community concerns here in Atlanta. He serves as advisor and surgeon for the FACE to FACE program, a program that provides treatment to women who are victims of domestic violence. He has also operated on patients. Viet Nam as part of his participation in the FACE to FACE program sponsored by the American Academy Facial Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery.

Dr. Silver is the son of Dr. Louis and Ester Silver. Dr. Louis Silver practiced Dentistry in Atlanta for fifty years and was actively involved in the community. Dr. William Silver is the grandson of Reverend PS Clein who was the shamus of the AA Synagogue for many years.

Dr. Silver remains active and continues to raise funding for UNICEF, American Cancer Society, American Heart Association, the Leukemia & Lymphoma Foundation, American Breast Cancer Society, Elton John AIDS foundation, and others.
