Silver named President of the Medical Association of Atlanta

William E. Silver, M.D. will be inaugurated June 20, 2007 as the ----President for the Medical Association of Atlanta.

Dr. Silver is a native of Atlanta and has practiced in the field of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery for over thirty years. He is founder and President of Premier Image Cosmetic & Laser Surgery and founded Dunwoody Outpatient Surgery Center, a nationally accredited outpatient surgery center located in Dunwoody, Georgia. This combination of services, served as Georgia's first multi-specialty cosmetic surgery practice to offer a complete range of services to the patient.

On the faculty of Emory University, Dr. Silver has been involved in teaching since he went into practice. He has served as a fellowship director for the American Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery for the past fifteen years. He is the author of many papers published in his specialty's publications and has co-written text books as well.

Dr. Silver has served as the Vice President of both the American Academy of Otolaryngology/Head and Neck Surgery and the American Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, the largest regional plastic surgery society. In addition to these duties, he has served as Chairman of the Board of Governors for the American Academy of Otolaryngology/Head and Neck Surgery and as President of both the Georgia Society of Otolaryngology/Head and Neck Surgery and the Metro Atlanta Otolaryngology Study Organization. He also served as the Chairman of the Medical Division for the Atlanta Jewish Federation.

Recently, Dr. Silver was honored by his peers to receive the Lester Brown Lifetime Service Award by the Georgia Society of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery. This award is given to a surgeon who has been in practice for more than twenty years, contributed by teaching medicine and has been involved in local and national service projects.

He serves as advisor and surgeon for the FACE to FACE program, a program that provides treatment to women who are victims of domestic violence. He is also active in the National FACE to FACE program sponsored by the American Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery traveling to Vietnam to provide restorative surgery to patients with traumatic injuries and birth defects.

Dr. Silver, his wife and two children reside here in Atlanta. They are passionately active in community concerns here in Atlanta. Dr. Silver continues to raise funding for UNICEF, American Cancer Society, American Heart Association, Leukemia & Lymphoma Foundation, American Breast Cancer Society, Elton John AIDS Foundation and others. Silver has remained committed to providing support for his local community and medical profession.
